

Planning after the Localism Bill



The Bill was laid before Parliament in December and proposes major changes in the relationships between government and local communities including the planning system. The Bill has both policy and practical implications for planners and proposes some new ways of working between different levels of government and with stakeholders and communities. It also provides a framework for two major planks of the Coalition Government's programme - the Big Society and Decentralisation.
