There will be a discussion of the problems of regenerating the wider area to the periphery of Sunnyside (outside the conservation area), where there is scope to redevelop on a more comprehensive basis, and the bringing into being of an SPD for the area (which is due for adoption by Council in July, having just completed public consultation) that is largely design led and thereby endeavouring to co-ordinate / reduce the excesses of the activities of the developers who are involved. Issues of “buy to let” and “buy to leave” will also be discussed.
