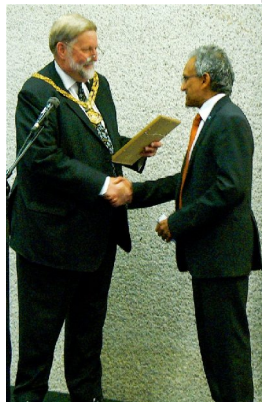

“We need to move from government to governance”

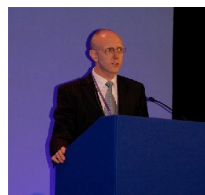


Planning in a changing economic climate
