This event, sponsored by Donarbon, will be taking place at Cambridgeshire's advanced Mechanical Biological Treatment (MBT) facility. It will cover a range of topical minerals and waste subjects, with the morning session focussing on waste and the afternoon on minerals.

Initial presentations on the links between waste planning and management, and exploring how high quality design and thorough public and member engagement can help deliver waste management infrastructure, will be followed by a presentation on the Environment Agency's revised groundwater policy.

A lunchtime visit around the Waste Management Park will be sandwiched by two legal presentations, covering judicial review (particularly in relation to the Surrey Capel case), the work of the Infrastructure Planning Commission, and perhaps an update on Environmental Impact Assessment legislation and other caselaw developments. The conference will close with the view of the Mineral Products Association on the effectiveness (or otherwise!) of the LDF system for minerals planning, and Suffolk County Council (currently the only county in the region with an adopted Minerals Core Strategy and Site Allocations DPDs) will share their experiences of achieving 'sound' DPDs.
