RTPI Assessment of Professional Competency (APC) Joint Mentor and Licentiate Events in Scotland

Due to previous high demand at the annual APC event in Scotland over the past few years, the Scottish Young Planners Network have now organised a series of joint Mentors' and Licentiates' APC events in four locations around Scotland for 2010.

Each event will last no longer than three hours and will be presented by Tracey Lloyd (RTPI Head of Membership & Careers), with breakout sessions and time for questions and answers. Members of the RTPI who have gone through the APC process will also be on hand to provide advice on their experience.

For a Mentor, these events will help to provide an overview of the APC process, outline the role of the mentor, provide an opportunity to ask the RTPI representative questions and share experiences and mentoring techniques with others.

For a Licentiate, these events will not only provide an overview of the APC process, but also establish what APC assessors are looking for in a final submission. The breakout sessions have been designed to allow for bespoke advice and discussions depending on what stage in the APC process you are at: the start, middle or nearing the final submission.
