## The Direct Debit Guarantee



- This guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits.
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit the Royal Town Planning Institute (RTPI) will notify you 5 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request the RTPI to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in payment of your Direct Debit, by the RTPI or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society.
  - If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when the RTPI asks you to.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify the RTPI.
