The RTPI Learning Partner Award recognises excellence in learning and development for planners by employers who have been accredited as RTPI Learning Partners.

How to enter:

All entries must be received by 10th September 16:00

Judging Criteria

All initiatives submitted for this award should demonstrate excellent learning and development for planners and the wider profession that has taken place during the **previous 24 months.**

Submitted entries must be a maximum of 800 words and may include images. You should address the following criteria:

- The original aim of the initiative
- How has the initiative added value for the individual employees?
- How has the initiative added value for the profession?
- How did you ensure there was fair and equal access to the initiative?

Eligibility

To be eligible your organisations must be a **RTPI Learning Partner**. For more information about becoming an RTPI Learning Partner <u>www.rtpi.orguk/learningpartners</u>

If you are not currently an RTPI Learning Partner, you can prepare an application for the RTPI Learning Partner Award as long as you become an RTPI Learning Partner by 10th September 2020.

Judging

The judging process will take place in September 2020. Commendations may be given in addition to the winner.

Awards presentation

The award will be presented by the RTPI President at the General Assembly in October.

The entry must be received at learning.partners@rtpi.org.uk or 41 Botolph Lane, London, EC3R 8DL by 16:00 on **10**th **September 2020.**

The entry form should be completed with no more than 800 words.

An entry will presume that there are no restrictions or fees payable for the reproduction of the photographs or any other submission materials. The RTPI retains **permission to publish** all submitted material and particulars of successful entries, including the judges' reports. This may include online and print publication, and successful entrants may be offered other promotional opportunities. Winning and shortlisted entries may feature as case studies in future RTPI work demonstrating best practice and the value of planning. Submitted material will be retained by the RTPI and will not be returned. The RTPI cannot accept any responsibility for submissions that are late, lost, mislaid or damaged by delivery companies.

It is recommended that entrants retain a copy of their submission.
