EXTRACT FROM THE GRAMPIAN CHAPTER CONSTITUTION

Adopted 20th May 2010

The Chapter Committee will comprise:

- Convener;
- Vice Convener;
- Honorary Secretary;
- Honorary Treasurer;
- Up to three Ordinary members, of any class of RTPI Membership; and
- One Student member.

The Convener may serve for no more than two consecutive years and will be replaced by the Vice-Convener. Appointments to all other positions will be by election at the AGM.

In the event of vacancies, the Committee may co-opt Office-bearers, Ordinary or Student members and shall aim to include representation from and both public and private sectors.

The Chapter Committee will nominate a representative to the Scottish Executive Committee, to serve for a term of two years. A deputy may attend meetings when the Representative is not able to attend in order to ensure that the Chapter's views are represented. Members are elected as individuals and are mandated to vote and act in the best interests of the Institute first, the Scottish Executive Committee second and the Chapter third. The Chapter does not have a mandate over the representative.

The Chapter Committee will nominate one of its members as Events Co-ordinator, whose responsibility will be to ensure that the programme of events is managed efficiently and timeously.

The Chapter may as appropriate appoint sub committees.
