




1) How important is planning for, protecting and siting trees for you in your work?

2) If trees are a priority in your work tell us why?



3. What are the issues you need to consider in management/planting of trees in an urban environment / rural environment?



4. Does your Local Planning Authority have a policy on trees and/or Forestry and Woodland strategies?





6. Would you like more training / CPD on trees?






8. Which nation do you work in most of the time?
